RIFLE/PISTOL RANGE

The pistol range “no blue sky” baffle structure is nearing completion. This set-up will essentially not allow bullets to leave the range while shooting in a down range direction due to horizontal and vertical containment. Bullet catchers at the end of the range will likely be completed this spring. The rifle range side will be worked on after completion of the pistol range. Upgrades will also include a “no blue sky” baffle set-up. We are also making the parking lot bigger.

As mentioned prior, all work is being completed by volunteers. We do need more help though as only a hand full of volunteers have been available.
